



## **HIGH ADVENTURE SAILING – Troop 777**

Our first sailing outing, as part of our planned series of High Adventure Sailing Treks, will be on 22 January 2005 (weather permitting). We will meet at the Encinitas Sports Authority parking lot at 9:00am in Class A uniforms and plan to return between 5pm and 6pm the same day.

The first Sailing outing will entail traveling to Dana Point Harbor and Marina where we will become familiar with a 30ft-32ft sailboat. Scouts will learn all aspects of the sailboat and begin to apply their skills in maneuvering and piloting a boat of this size. Upon demonstrating reasonable proficiency in handling various deck assignments, we will embark upon a short day sail where scouts will eventually command and control the sailboat under the supervision of the attending trek leaders and instructors.

Scouts are requested to bring the following:

- Sneakers or Deck Shoes (no black or colored soles as they mark the boat).
- Shorts and T-Shirts (if warm weather is anticipated) and long pants/jeans and a sweatshirt.
- Bag Lunch (drinks will be provided by the Assistant Scout Masters).
- Sun Block.
- Permission slip with parental permission (see below).
- \$27 - cash or check (made out to James Mastrogany).
