First summer camp scouts should enroll in the Pathfinders program where emphasis is on Tenderfoot through First Class advancement. Pathfinders is an excellent introductory level program which, still allows scouts to take some merit badges.

**Mataguay Communications Center** (help operate the camp's own AM Radio Station, *KMSR*, working on Radio, Journalism and/or Public Speaking MB or help publish the camp's newspaper, *The Mataguay Messenger*, working on Journalism and Photography MB)

**Prerequisite:** All scouts *and* adults leaders must be fully registered and have current Class 3 Medical forms.

**Meet at:** 10:00am Sunday at the Sports Authority in complete and correct uniform

**Return:** Saturday, mid-day. *Note: Families are encouraged to attend the camp's Friday night spaghetti dinner (\$5 per adult) and/or camp the night, taking their son home on Saturday. No scout may leave Friday night without pre-arranging this with Mr. Mihalik and clearly checking out with him or the Asst. SM in charge before leaving. Each scout parent is expected to drive up to or back from camp.*
