EVENT: COLORADO RIVER CANOE TREK

DATES: Monday April 4 through Thursday April 7, 2005

DESCRIPTION: We will drive to Walter's Camp, on the lower Colorado River, on Monday afternoon, and camp there Monday night. On Tuesday morning, we will begin our trip. We will paddle on the relatively quiet waters of the lower Colorado River. Along the way, we will visit Lonesome's Grave, and one or two old homesteads. We will also stop at an old gold mine, where there are the ruins of a huge gold stamp mill, and a unique town jail. Finally, we paddle a narrow path through tall reeds. We will return to Encinitas Thursday afternoon.

PREREQUISITE: Parent permission, Canoeing Merit Badge, and Salty Rat. Previous canoeing experience may be accepted in lieu of Salty Rat, at the discretion of the trek leader.

COST: Approximately \$120, includes canoe rental (canoe, paddle, PFD), camping fees, and food (Cookmasters wanted). We will eat well.

INSTRUCTIONS: Since we have to reserve canoes, and campgrounds in advance, please submit your signup and money by the Troop meeting of March 21 (sooner is BETTER).

There will be two planning meetings to prepare for this trip. One of the meetings will be the weekend preceding April 4 to pack the food. Attendance at these meetings is mandatory.
