Event: **Scout Fair 2005**

Date: April 23, 2005 9am – 4pm

Description: The Scout Fair is Scouting's showcase for the community to show what Scouting is all about. As in previous years, we will be operating in the Council's **High Adventure Area**. Our display this year will show off our backpacking knowledge with a display of backpacks from a variety of eras, and we'll be staffing our booth with our Philmont trekkers and just a few other volunteers (3 to four per shift). We'd like each Scout to bring their loaded backpack so they can show and tell booth visitors how they like to do things their own way, but we'll also have a variety of other packs on display.

We **strongly** encourage all of our Scouts to attend the Fair with their families. Make sure you drop in to visit our display!

Meet at: Southwest parking lot of **QUALCOMM STADIUM** in the **High Adventure Area**. Drivers should plan on leaving 30 minutes prior to the start of the shift. The High Adventure Area is located at about the 7 o'clock position just off of the circular area with the main flagpole. It is sandwiched between the Pioneering and Cooking areas.

Times: We will staff our booth in 3 overlapping shifts of 3 hours each. The Fair itself runs from 9am until 4pm. Venture scouts are distributed throughout each shift. Anyone needing to change their shift time should contact their Shift leaders and let them know the shift they will attend by Friday, April 22nd so they know who to expect.
