EVENT: COLORADO RIVER CANOE TREK

DATES: Sunday April 9 through Thursday April 13, 2006

DESCRIPTION: We will drive to Park Moabi, near Needles, California, on Sunday. The following morning we will take a short bus ride to Bullhead City, Arizona, where we will put in the water. Once on the river, we will paddle on the relatively quiet waters of the Colorado River. Along the way, we will see the casinos of Laughlin, Nevada, an original Route 66 bridge, and abundant wildlife. The 2nd night we'll be back at Park Moabi for hot showers and reprovisioning. From there we paddle through scenic Topock Gorge, past Castle Rock, and end up at London Bridge. We will return to Encinitas Thursday evening.

IMPORTANT – THIS TRIP IS REQUIRED FOR THOSE WHO PLAN TO GO TO BOUNDARY WATERS IN JULY.

PREREQUISITE: Canoeing Merit Badge.

FOOD BUY: The food buy will occur midday on Saturday, April 8. Only the Cook-masters are required to attend. Following the food buy, ALL CANOEISTS ARE REQUIRED to come help pack the food. Packing will start at approximately 1 pm, at the home of (to be determined).

COST: Approximately \$140, includes camping fees, canoe rental (canoe, paddle, PFD), transportation and food.

DEPARTURE: We will meet at 9:30 am on Sunday April 9, at a location to be determined. Come with all gear packed. Travel in Class A uniform.
