Event: Ansell Adams Backpacking Trip

Date: Friday Aug. 10th to Monday Aug. 14th 2007

Description: 3 day of Backpacking in one of the most beautiful area of the Sierras. The Ansell Adams area is located east of Mammoth Lakes. It's a spectacular area with rivers, lakes, waterfalls and breathtaking Alpine Vista. This is not a beginner trek but intermediate. We will cover between 8 to 10 miles every day at elevation ranging from 8,000ft to 10,000 ft.

Prerequisite: There will be 2 mandatory trips in May (Mt Laguna) and June (St Jacinto). Participating in the Camelback is also recommended. There will be a required backpack inspection before leaving for this trip.
Class 3 medical form on file with troop.

Trekking Description.

Day 1 (Saturday): Start from Agnew Meadows trailhead, hike along the River trail, up to Shadow lake and end the day at Garnet Lake.

Day 2 (Sunday): From Garnet Lake to Thousand Island Lake in the morning. Set up camp and lunch. Afternoon day hike to base of Mt. Ritter and Lake Catherine (no trail)

Day 3: Agnew Pass and back to trailhead through the PCT. Drive back to Encinitas

Meet: Sports Authority parking lot 9:00 a.m. Friday Aug 10th. Travel in Class A uniform. Bring lunch sack with you for the road.

Return: Monday Aug 14th late (around 9 pm)

Cost: \$57/trekker (\$28 for gas, \$24 for food buy, and \$5 for wilderness permit)

Other: bring some snack money for the drive home

Instructions: Contact Trek Leader by phone or e-mail to inform on intent to participate on this trek. Bring signed permission slip at troop meetings. Please call Mr. Canler (760-942-5441) to let him know you will be going.
