Event: MATAGUAY SUMMER CAMP

Date: July 13- July 19, 2008

Description: Summer camp is the quintessential scout experience where adventure-'n- advancement and comradery-'n-competition come together. Mataguay Scout Reservation (MSR) is our own San Diego-Imperial Council resident camp located just east of Lake Henshaw in a secluded valley canopied by Live Oak trees. It has one of the most extensive advancement and activities programs in the country. It is renowned for its campfires, camp wide competitions and its Custard's Last Stand, one incredible water balloon fight between the staff and the scouts!

First summer camp scouts should enroll in the Pathfinders program where emphasis is on Tenderfoot through First Class advancement. Pathfinders is an excellent introductory level program which still allows scouts to take some merit badges.

Each scout parent is expected to drive up to or back from camp.*
