Description: Summer camp is the quintessential scout experience where adventure and advancement and camaraderie and competition come together. Circle X is located in the Forest Lawn Scout Reserve near Cedar Glen (Lake Arrowhead). First year scouts should enroll in the Pathfinder program where emphasis is on Tenderfoot through First Class advancement. Merit Badges: Sign up for merit badges will be May timeframe. Merit badge information will be posted on Troop website when it becomes available.

Information: Information about Circle X Summer Camp will be posted on a web page on the Troop website.

Prerequisite: **All scouts and adult leaders must be fully registered and have current (through July 14, 2012) Medical forms. Forms should be turned into Jerry Shiller. A current copy of the scout's health insurance card must be turned in as well. All leaders must have current Youth Protection Training.**

Meet at/Return: The scouts will late morning on Sunday and must be in complete and correct uniform. It will be a long and busy first day; the trekkers' first meal at camp is dinner and it isn't until around 6PM. Trekkers must pack a lunch and drink.
