



## ASSISTANT SENIOR PATROL LEADER

**Position description:** The assistant senior patrol leaders are the second highest-ranking youth leaders in the troop. An assistant senior patrol leader acts as the senior patrol leader in the absence of the senior patrol leader or when called upon. They also provides leadership to other youth leaders in the troop, especially patrol leaders.

**Reports to:** The senior patrol leader

### **Assistant senior patrol leader duties:**

- Helps the senior patrol leader prepare for and lead meetings and activities.
- Runs the troop in the absence of the senior patrol leader.
- Calls the patrols by Friday to delegate tasks for the next week's meeting.
- Lends a hand controlling the patrols and building patrol spirit.
- Helps train and supervise the patrol leaders, troop scribe, quartermaster, instructor, librarian, historian, and chaplain's aide.
- Serves as a member of the troop leader council (TLC).
- Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
- Lives the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows Scout spirit.
