Position description: The patrol leader is the elected leader of his patrol. He represents his patrol on the troop leader council (TLC).

Reports to: The assistant senior patrol leaders

Patrol leader duties:

- Keeps patrol members informed.
- Calls the patrol by Saturday to keep patrol members informed.
- Plans and leads patrol meetings and activities.
- Helps the senior patrol leader prepare for and lead meetings and activities.
- Represents the patrol on the troop leader council (TLC).
- Appoints the assistant patrol leader.
- Helps Scouts advance.
- Knows what his patrol members and other leaders can do.
- Sets the example.
- Wears the uniform correctly.
- Lives the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows Scout spirit.
