Reports to: The Scoutmaster

Senior patrol leader duties:

- Runs all troop meetings, events, and activities. Arranges for a delegate when he is not there.
- Runs the troop leader council (TLC) meeting.
- Calls the scoutmaster by Wednesday to discuss the next week's meeting.
- Calls the TLC by Thursday to delegate tasks for the next week's meeting.
- Appoints other troop youth leaders with the advice and counsel of the Scoutmaster.
- Assigns duties and responsibilities to youth leaders.
- Assists the Scoutmaster with youth leadership training.
- Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly.
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows Scout spirit.
